Mavericks Water Polo wants athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers and spectators to have a safe environment within which to train and compete. The club does NOT own facilities. However, it rents facilities from reputable organizations including Ontario municipalities, school boards and universities, all of which have rigorous facility safety requirements

Policy:

Mavericks Water Polo abides by the facility safety policies of the owners of the pools it rents.

During workouts and competition, Mavericks requires at least 1 coach/guard on deck for every 25 athletes, who has NLS, first aid training **and** facility specific training.

Upon registration, athletes/ parents are required to provide regular and emergency contact information. Coaches have this emergency contact info for each athlete in their group on a readily accessible info sheet. In addition, emergency contact info is also available in our on line NSO registration system.

The coaches and athletes have primary and secondary muster points where they will meet in the event that a facility in which they train must be evacuated.
